Drylining Apprenticeship

As an apprentice interior systems installer, the candidate will work alongside experienced staff, building up knowledge, skills and responsibility, and supporting the delivery of our services whilst working towards a Level 2 Interior Systems-Drylining Systems Installer apprenticeship.

As part of the **apprenticeship you will:**

- **Complete a programme** of training as an Interior Systems (Drylining) Installer apprentice.
- **Attend training** at training institution to achieve professional Level 2 Internal Systems (Drylining) Installer qualification.
- **Duration:** usually 18 to 24 months.

How to **apply**

We advertise our vacancies on the National Apprenticeship Service website and on TalentView. Prospective apprentices can always contact us directly using our email address: info@gypcraftltd.co.uk Candidates will need to show a genuine interest in drylining and enthusiasm in undertaking a career in drylining.

The **selection process**

Selected applications/CVs will move to the first stage, which includes an interview. This interview allows us to get to know the candidate better and assess whether they have a genuine interest in pursuing a career as a dryliner. We also evaluate their commitment to undertaking a challenging but rewarding period of learning, working, and gaining experience in this trade.

Depending on the interview outcome, prospective apprentices may be invited to participate in additional stages of the selection process. These stages include a site visit and a work experience period. Successful candidates will then be offered a position as a drylining apprentice.



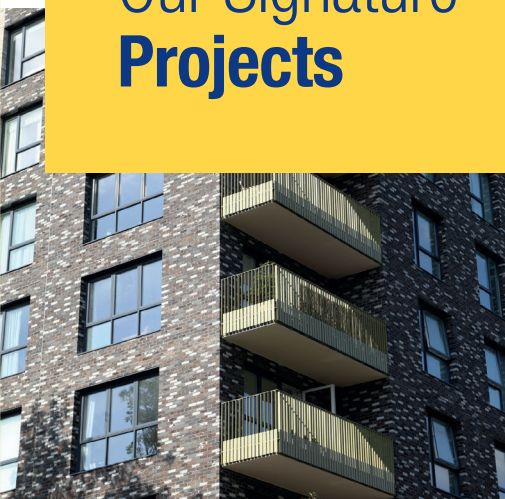
What will an **Apprentice** be doing?

Main duties

- **Work toward** a level 2 Interior Systems (Drylining) Installer Apprenticeship.
- **Maintain** a logbook over the duration of the apprenticeship period and a portfolio recording projects and documenting work that has been undertaken and the skills learned.
- **Learn and adhere** to safety protocols and best practices on construction sites.
- **Follow instructions** from mentors and supervisors to ensure projects are completed accurately and efficiently.
- **Assisting with the installation** of interior systems, including drylining, partitioning, and ceiling systems.
- **Learning to interpret** construction drawings, specifications, and plans to ensure accurate installation.
- **Assisting with the preparation and measurement** of materials required for installation.
- **Assisting with the cutting, shaping, and fitting** of drylining materials, partitions, and ceilings.
- **Assisting with the installation of insulation, soundproofing, and fireproofing** materials.
- **Learning to use hand and power tools** safely and efficiently.
- **Maintaining** a clean and organized work area.
